2018 FISU World University Floorball Championship will be held in Lodz, Poland from June 26th to 30th 2018.

FISU Regulations

General terms:

The Floorball tournaments shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the International Floorball Federation (IFF). In any dispute, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The competitions shall last from three (3) to five (5) days depending on the number of participants and include:

- One (1) men's tournament
- One (1) women's tournament

Each country is authorised to enter, for each team, a maximum of twenty-seven (27) persons: a maximum of twenty (20) players and seven (7) officials.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/ her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.



Pre-competition procedure

The countries participating in the Floorball tournament shall pay a deposit of 5000 EUR per team to guarantee registration (Art. 5.4.4).

This deposit shall be paid to FISU at the latest five (5) months prior to the start of the Championship; failing this, the entries shall not be taken into consideration.

The participating teams are seeded in their groups according to their ranking. The ranking of teams for WUC competitions takes into account both the FISU and IFF rankings. The IFF ranking is used as a repair factor for the FISU ranking when teams have not participated in the same number of FISU events.

Group distribution shall be based on rankings and the number of groups is decided by the WUC Department in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The grouping shall be made after the final number of participating teams is confirmed. Groups phase and knock-out stage systems to be decided based on the number and level of participating teams.



Financial Conditions:

Obligations of the delegations towards FISU:

FISU registration fee is **20 EUR** per person – payable to FISU.

FISU fees invoicing will be made upon arrival, transfer is made by NUSF after the event.

Obligations towards the Organizing Committee:

Participation fee is **70 EUR** per person per day (night).

For additional single rooms, extra fee of **20 EUR**/per person/ per night.

Referee fee: **575 EUR** per team.

25% of the total cost of the stay per athlete entered and officials of the delegation should be paid three (3) months before the Championship.

Balance of Participation fees can be made upon arrival, however OC recommends payment before the event for both sides' convenience. **No possibility to pay by credit card on site.**

General information about Poland:

- **Language:** Polish, but one can easily communicate in English
- **Currency:** Polish Zloty (PLN), 1 EUR = c.a. 4,30 PLN

TRANSPORT

Official Transport:

The official WUC airports are **Chopin Airport Warsaw (WAW)** and **Reymont Airport Lodz (LCJ)**. Another arrival/departure points are **Lodz – Kaliska** and **Lodz - Fabryczna** train stations. The Organising Committee will provide for all participants of the Championship: free transportation to/from the arrival/departure point and the hotel as well as connections between the competition venue, ceremonies, social activities, and hotels.

Public Transport:

In addition to official transport, all Championship accreditation badge holders will be entitled to free public transport for the duration of the event. Lodz is very well connected by a net of tram and bus lines, allowing for any point in the city to be reached by public transport, operated by MPK – Lodz. ACCOMMODATION

During World University Floorball Championship, athletes, officials and referees will stay at hotels in the city of Lodz. Room occupancy will be in accordance with FISU regulations.

The Organising Committee will provide for each country 1 single room (for the Head of the Delegation) and twin or triple rooms for the team members. It is possible to book an extra single room with the additional fee of 20 EUR/per person/ per night. To book the extra single room please contact the OC until the 1st of May 2018. The number of single rooms is limited.

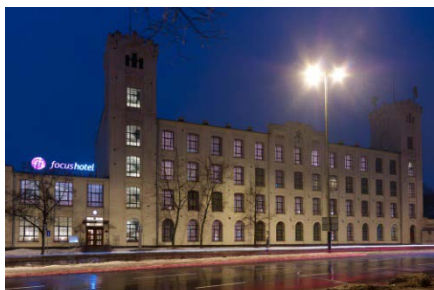

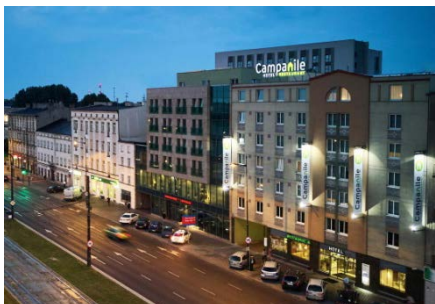

ADDITIONAL INFO

Physio/ Massage:

Separate rooms for physio will not be provided at the hotels. Instead, designated zone will be made available at the competition venues. **The OC does not provide massage tables.**

Laundry:

Laundry rooms at a student dormitory close to competition venues will be available free of charge for the teams, according to a schedule corresponding the match schedule. **The OC does not provide laundry detergents.**

Meeting Rooms:

Meeting rooms for team meetings will be available at teams' hotels, free of charge in the evening by earlier reservation at the reception desk.



CATERING

3 meals will be provided to all participants, according to the schedule below:

- **Breakfast**

Served at hotel, breakfast time according to hotel schedule (earlier breakfast possible if requested at the reception desk at least a day before)
Buffet style.

- **Lunch 11:00 - 17:00**

Served at Serenissima Restaurant*, Politechniki 3, 93-590 Lodz
Selection of several meals, including special diets.

- **Dinner 18:00 – 21:00****

Served at Serenissima Restaurant*, Politechniki 3, 93-590 Lodz

MEDICAL SERVICE

Medical care during the FISU WUC Floorball 2018 is available. First aid, EMT, and on-site physicians will be guaranteed according to the FISU regulations and the Polish law for sports events.

During official trainings, medical service will be provided by a paramedic available at the competition venue. During competitions, full EMT with ambulance will be present on site.

DOPING CONTROL

The Organising Committee will meet all requirements on doping control in accordance with FISU regulations. All necessary measures will be taken by certified personnel according to current standards of the Polish Anti-doping Agency. The testing laboratory will be chosen by NADA officials prior to the event. All corresponding legal aspects are in line with FISU regulations. AZS as well as the Polish Floorball Federation have agreements concerning doping control with the Polish Anti-Doping Agency. These agreements are based on the WADA Code.



COMPETITION VENUES

Sports Bay

Politechniki 10, 93-590 Lodz

“Sports Bay” is Lodz University of Technology brand new sports complex, containing an Olympic- size swimming pool, diving tower and pool, climbing walls, badminton courts and indoor sports hall, which will serve as the primary competition venue during WUC Floorball. The playing ground is 45m long and 31m wide; the seating capacity is 500 seats. The hall is equipped with state-of-the-art sound and broadcasting equipment, suitable for high-profile sport events. The building also houses conference rooms, offices and a bar.



MOSiR City Sports Hall

Skorupki 21, 90-001 Lodz

MOSiR hall on Skorupki street, built in 1957 in the center of the city, was for many years the primary sports complex in Lodz. The hall is used as a venue for not only sport competitions, but also various mass events, such as concerts and fairs. The playing ground is 62m long and 37m wide with a wooden floor. Spectator seating capacity is 300 seats. During WUC Floorball, the hall will serve as a secondary venue.

Qualification rules

The ranking within a group shall be decided in the following order:

- a) The total number of points.
- b) If two or more teams have the same number of points, the internal matches of the teams concerned, the internal goal difference included if necessary, shall be decisive.
- c) If the internal matches according to b) are not decisive, most scored goals internally shall be decisive.
- d) If the ranking cannot be decided by the internal matches, the total goal difference of the teams concerned shall be decisive.
- e) If the total goal difference is not decisive, most scored goals of the teams concerned shall be decisive.
- f) If most scored goals is not decisive a drawing of lot with the teams concerned shall settle the ranking.

Qualification in Men's tournament

- A1, A2, B1 and B2 qualify for semifinals
- Semifinals: A1-B2 and B1-A2

Ranking games (bronze game and final games home team will be decided by a draw):

- 5th place: pool of teams A3, A4, B3
- Bronze game
- Final

Qualification in Women's tournament

- A1 and B1 qualify for semifinals
- A2-B3 and B2-A3 play quarterfinals
- Semifinals: A1-(winner B2-A3) and B1-(winner A2-B3).

Ranking games (home team will be decided by a draw):

- 5th place: losers of the quarterfinals
- Bronze game
- Final



OFFICIAL TRAINING

All participating teams are entitled to **60minutes** of training at official competition venues. Official training will be held on June 24th and 25th (until General Technical Meeting).

The organizer does not provide balls for training.

The training schedule is set by the OC, based on teams' travel plans and requests.
